Create your CCC account:

Creating an account will allow you to become more familiar with CCC. Once you create an account you can schedule a campus visit, register for an admissions event, or apply for admission at www.cccneb.edu/Account/

Schedule a campus visit:

Schedule a visit online at www.cccneb.edu/Visit/ OR call the Admissions Office on the campus of your choice.

Complete and application for admission:

- Log into your CCC Account to complete the free online application at www.cccneb.edu/Apply/

** Some programs require additional applications and/or have special requirements and deadlines for admission.

Check with the Admissions Office of your choice for more information.

Review your residency status:

- In-State vs Out-of-State Residency: Students residing in the state of Nebraska for 180 days or more will receive in-state tuition.
- Midwest Student Exchange: Students residing in Kansas, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, North Dakota, & Wisconsin may be eligible to apply for a discounted tuition rate through the Midwest Student Exchange Program.

Complete a mandatory pre-enrollment assessment:

- Have your ACT (school code 6369) or Accuplacer scores sent to CCC.
- If you would like to schedule an exam at any of the CCC locations, please call:

** Completing a pre-enrollment assessment is required to register for classes. Scores must be current from the last three (3) years.

Visit www.cccneb.edu/assessment/ for test prep and exemptions.

Complete the FAFSA (www.fafsa.gov) if you are interested in financial aid:

- You may begin FAFSA starting on October 1 of your senior year using your previous year's tax return.
- Use financial aid code: 014468

Apply for scholarships:

- Due February 15 – Seniors, if you receive a letter saying that you are eligible for an ACT or Assessment Advantage Scholarship, follow the instructions on the letter to apply for the scholarship.
- Due March 1 – Complete the General Scholarship Application on our website at www.cccneb.edu/Scholarships/
Filling out this application will put you in the running for over 100 scholarships.
- Due April 15 – If you are considering taking a summer course and attend a high school within CCC's 25 county service area, complete the Summer Scholarship application on our website at www.cccneb.edu/Scholarships/
- Check with your guidance counselor about other community scholarships.

If you wish to live on-campus in Hastings or Columbus:

- Complete the housing contract and submit a \$150 deposit to secure your room and board at www.cccneb.edu/Housing/
- If you wish to cancel and get your deposit back, please refer to the grace period dates listed in the housing contract.
