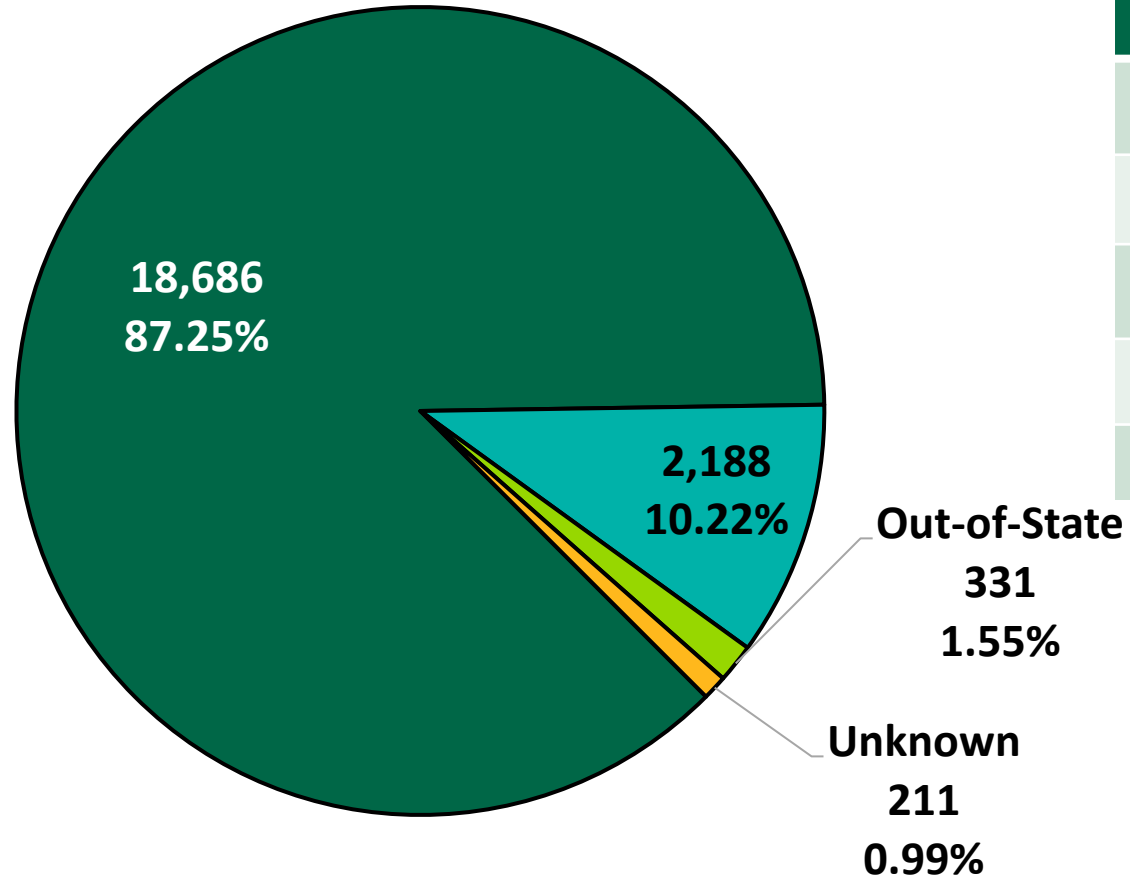

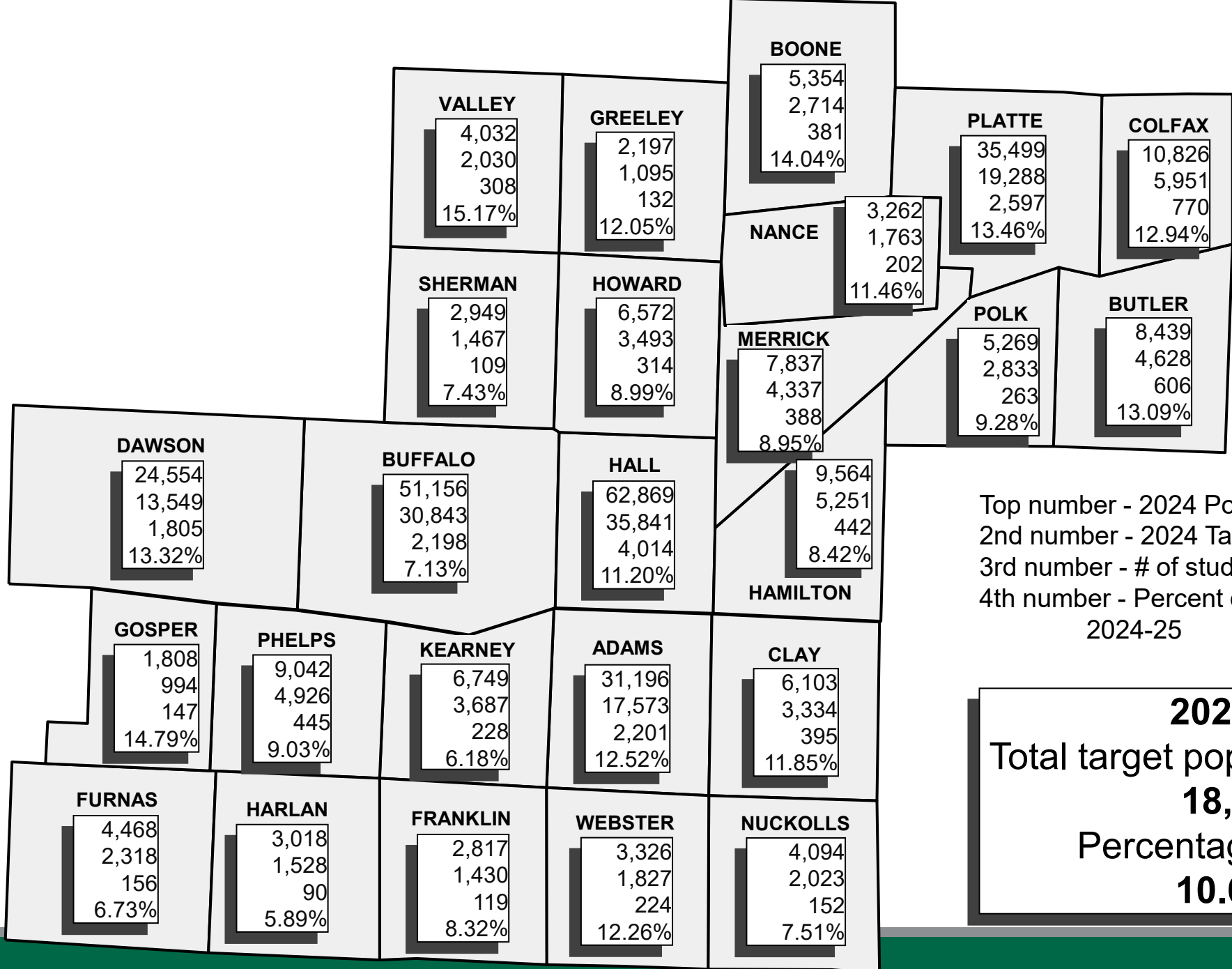

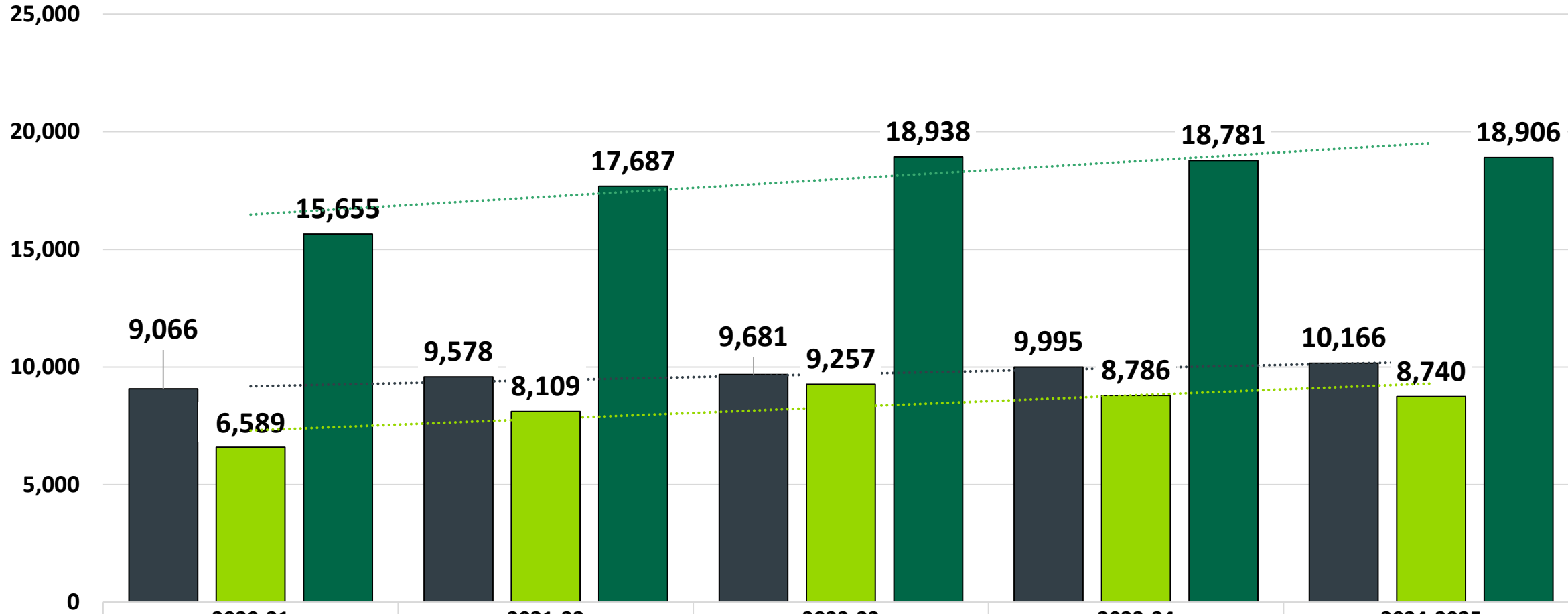

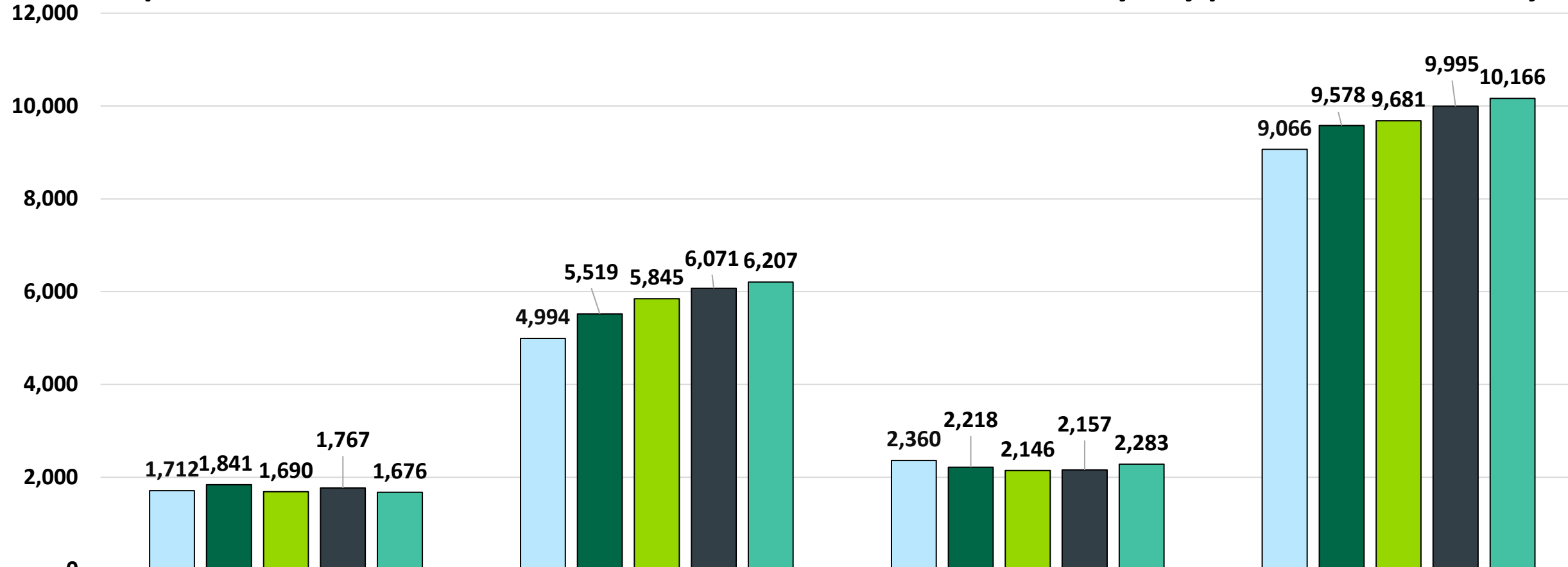

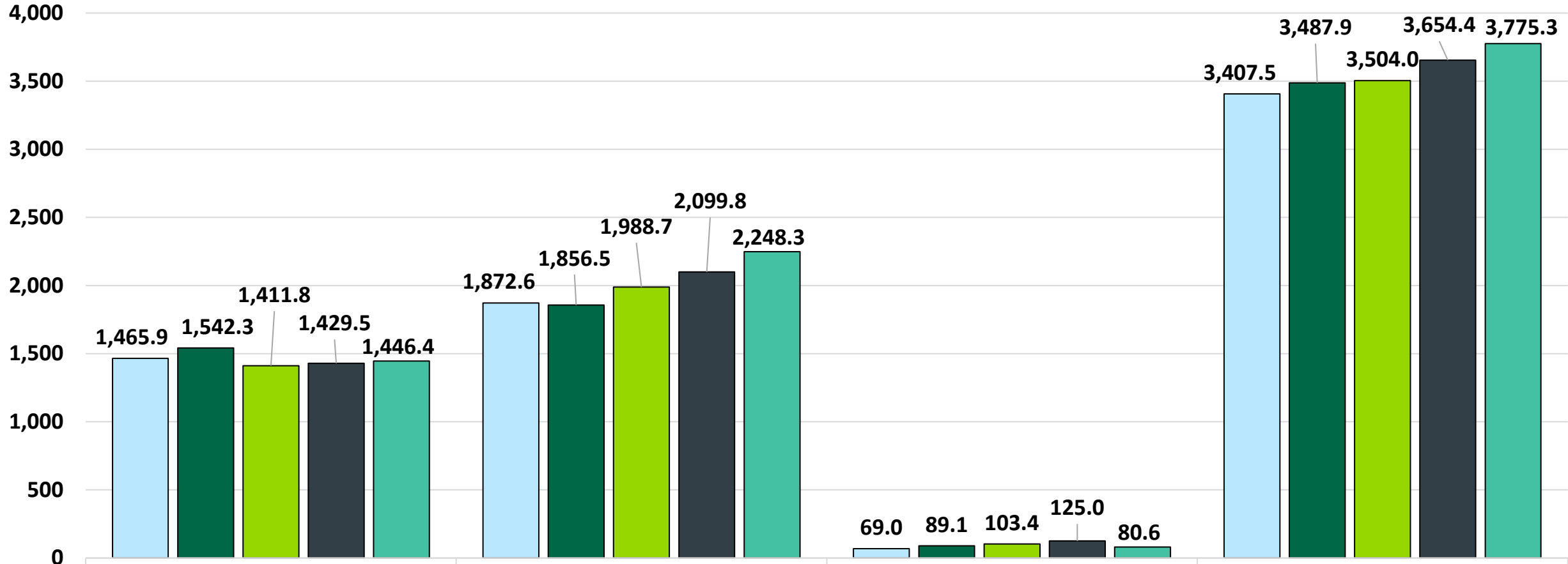

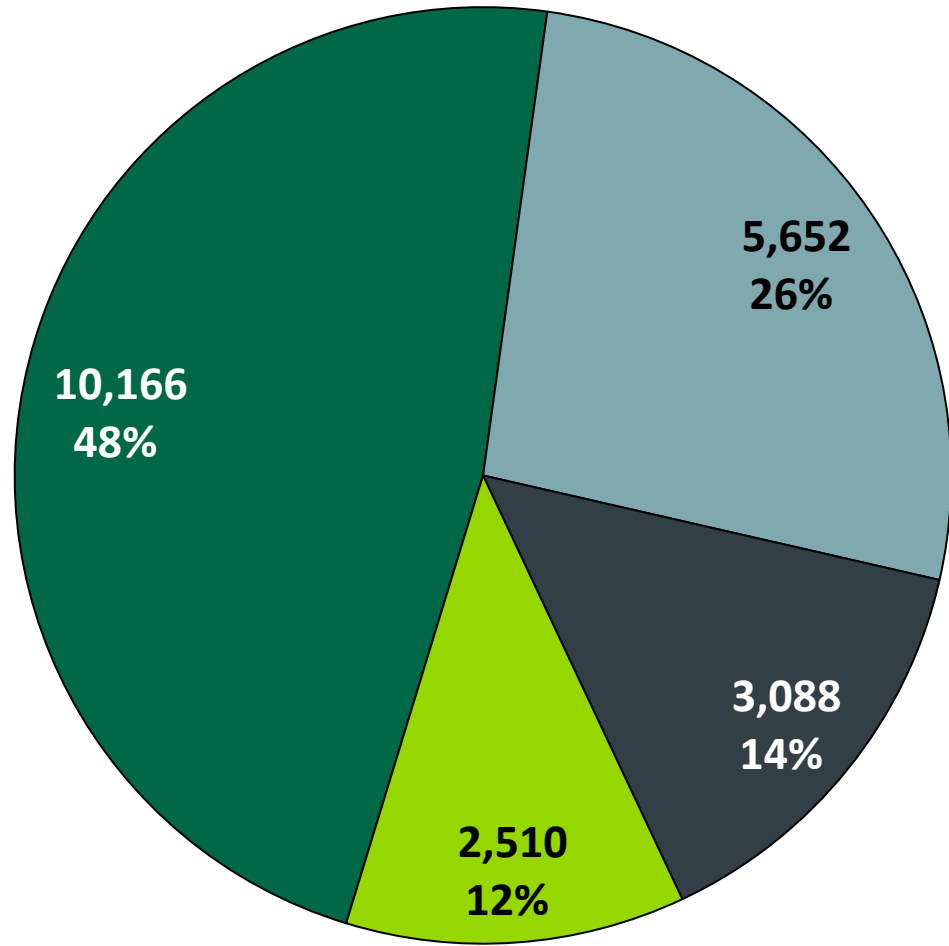

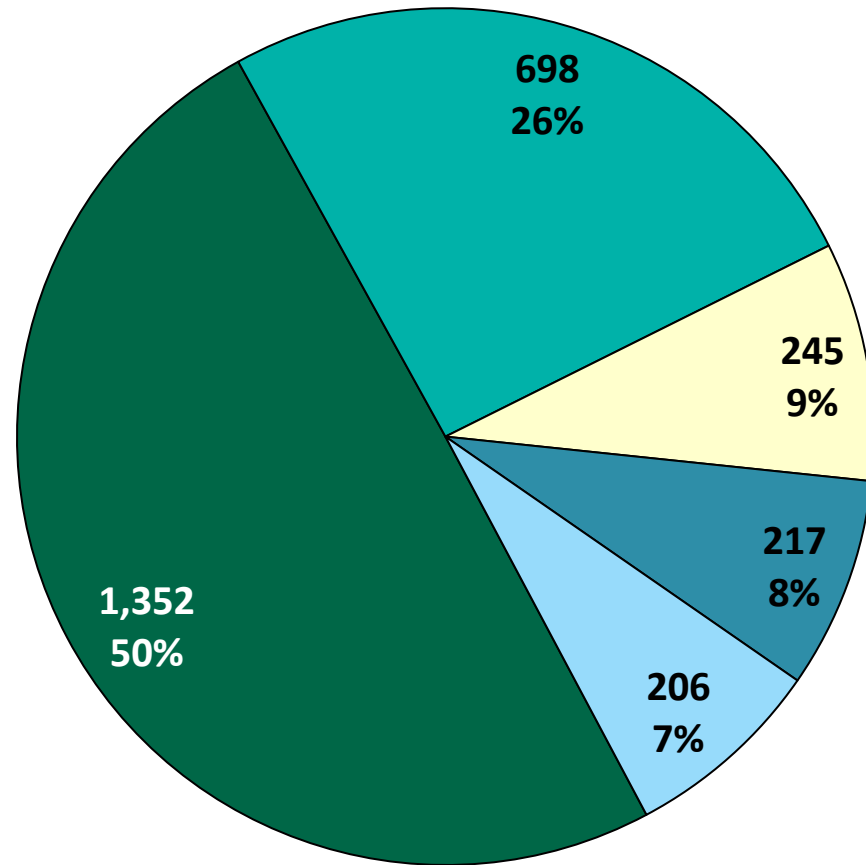

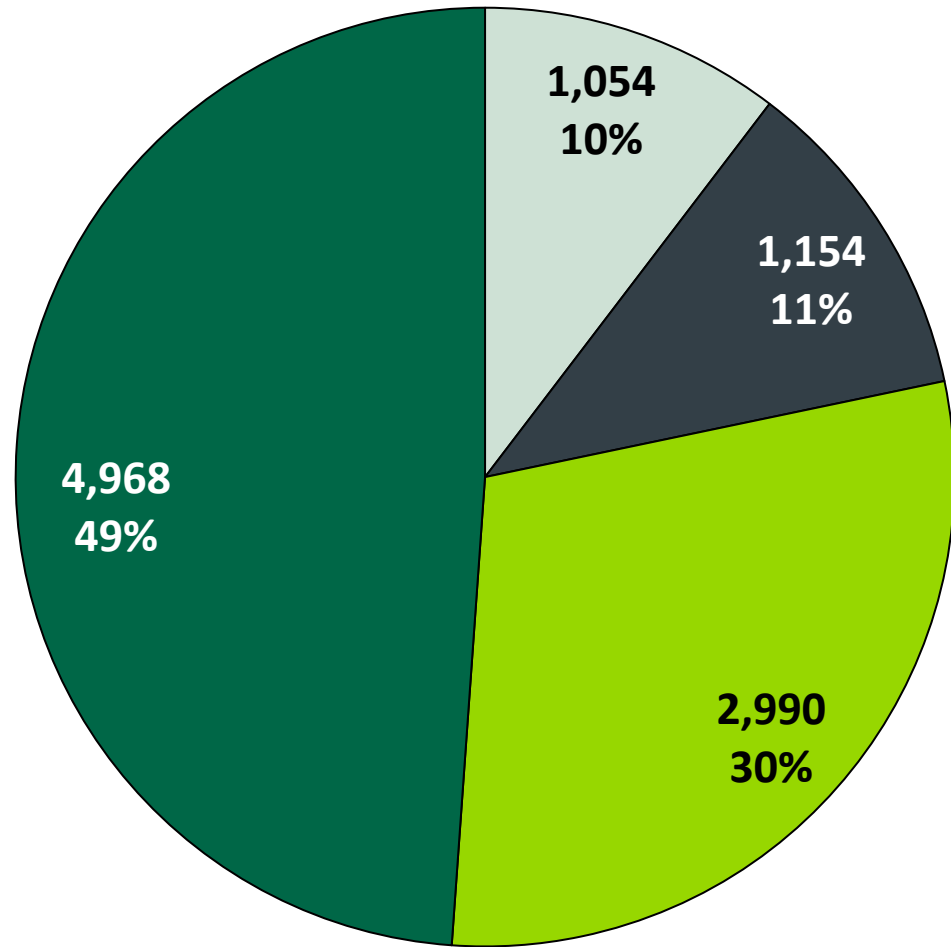

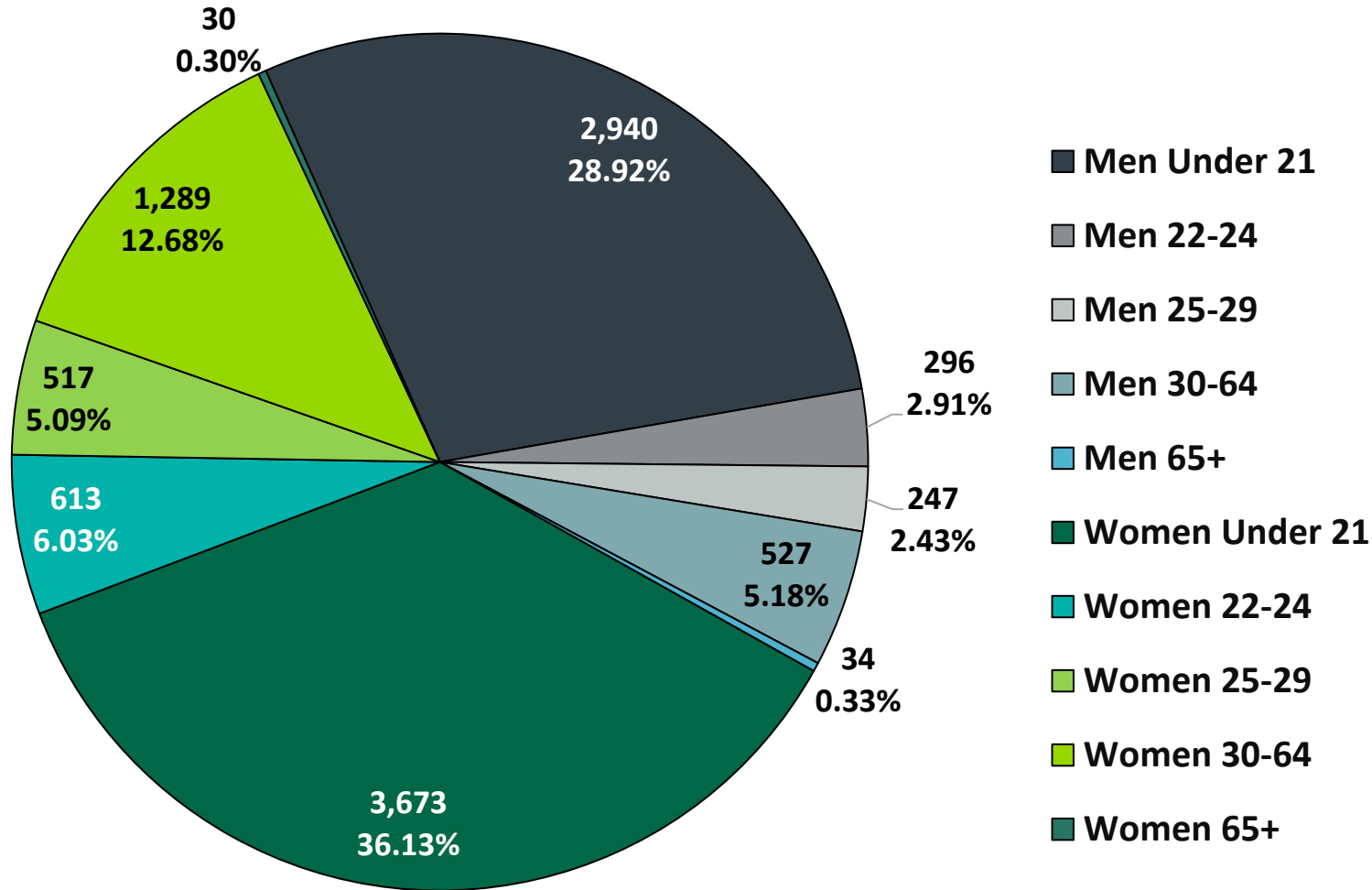

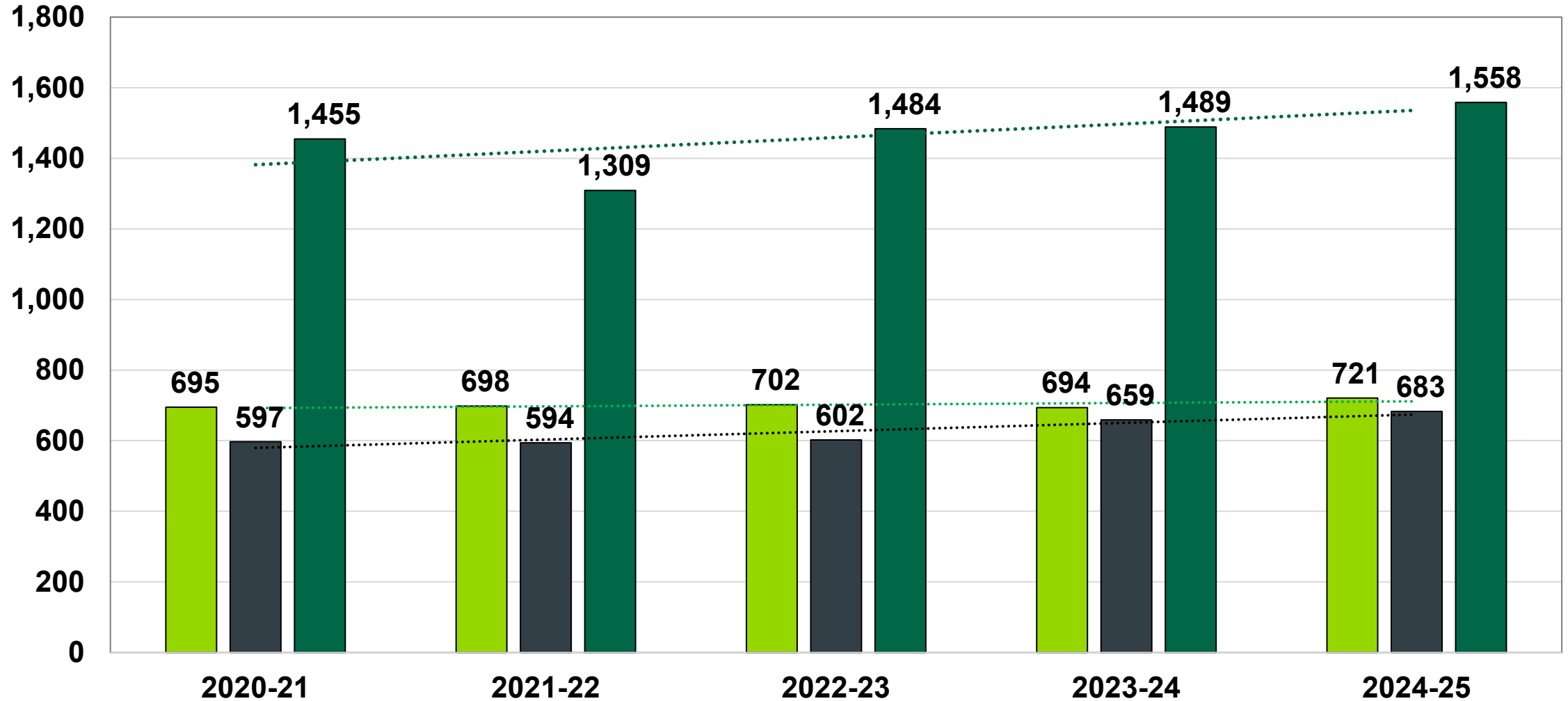

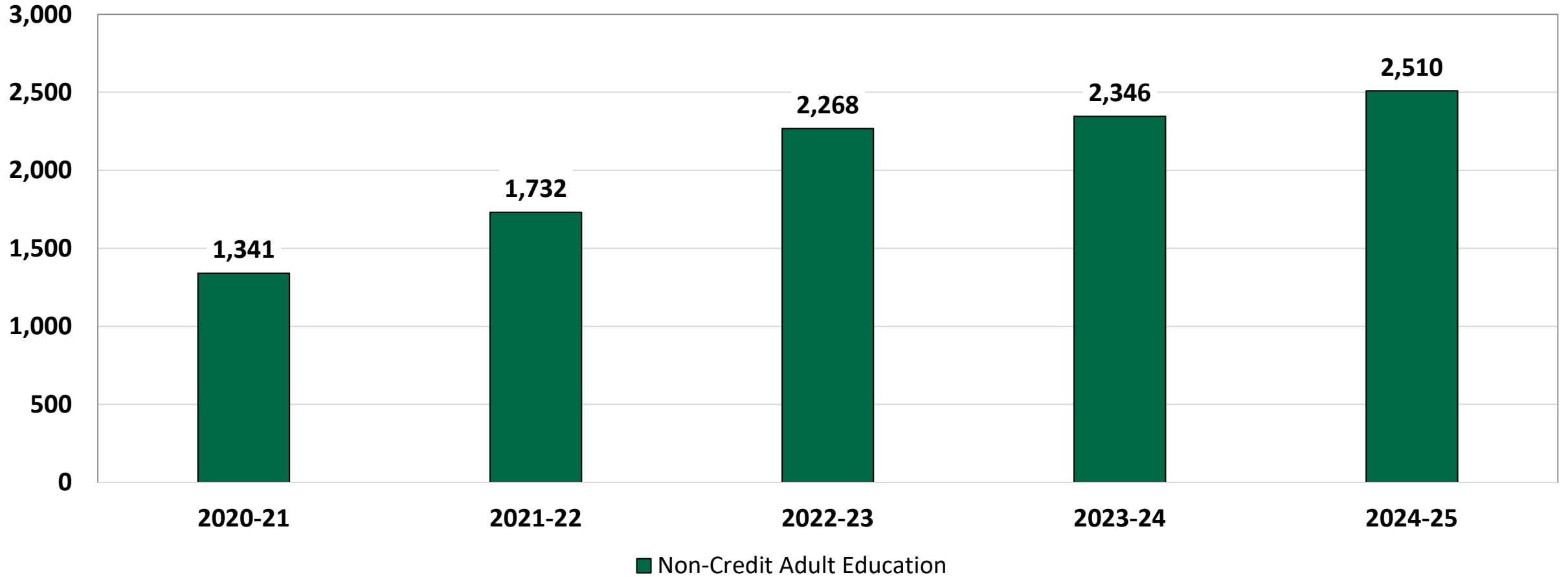
# Total Number of Awards College-wide

- 1,989 Low ABE (Up to and including 5<sup>th</sup> grade)
  - Includes 1,955 ESL and 34 ABE students
- 345 Intermediate ABE (6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade)
- 62 Adult Secondary ABE (9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade)
  - 85 passed tests to obtain the GED
- 114 Level undefined (did not complete placement test)
- 102,601.25 student contact hours
