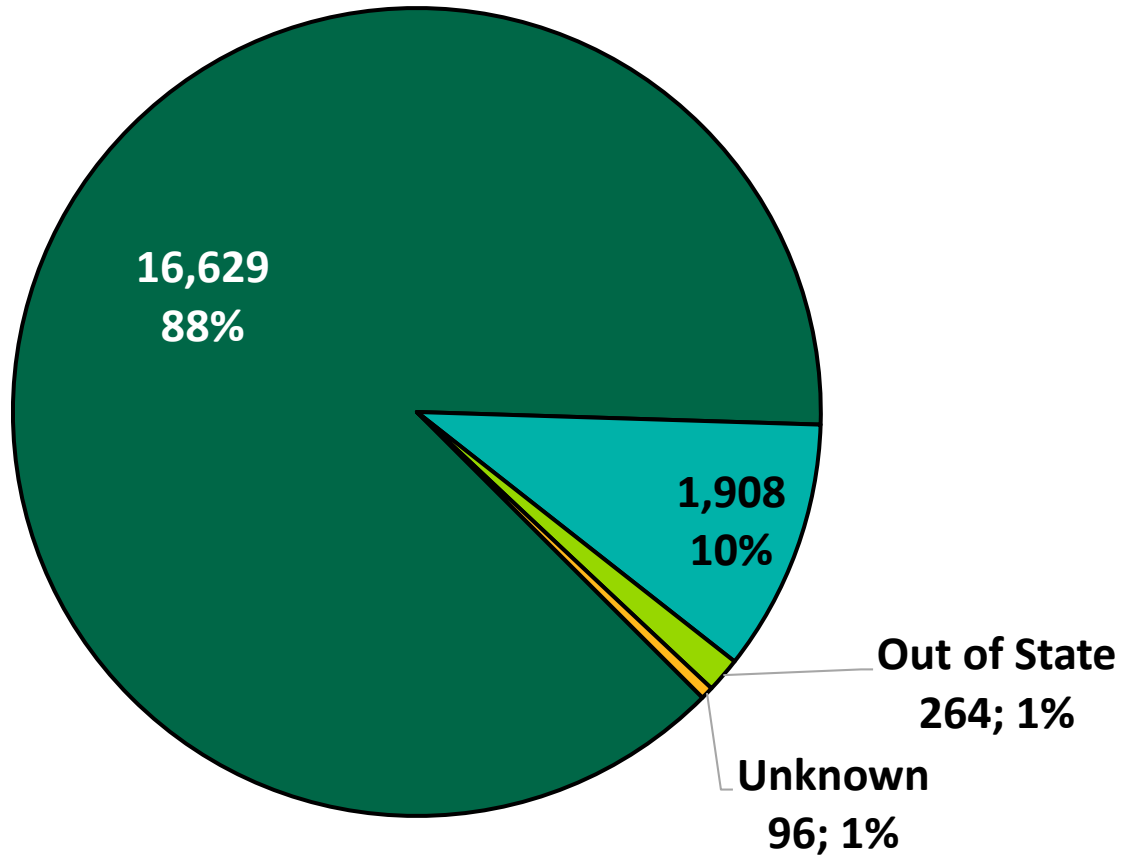

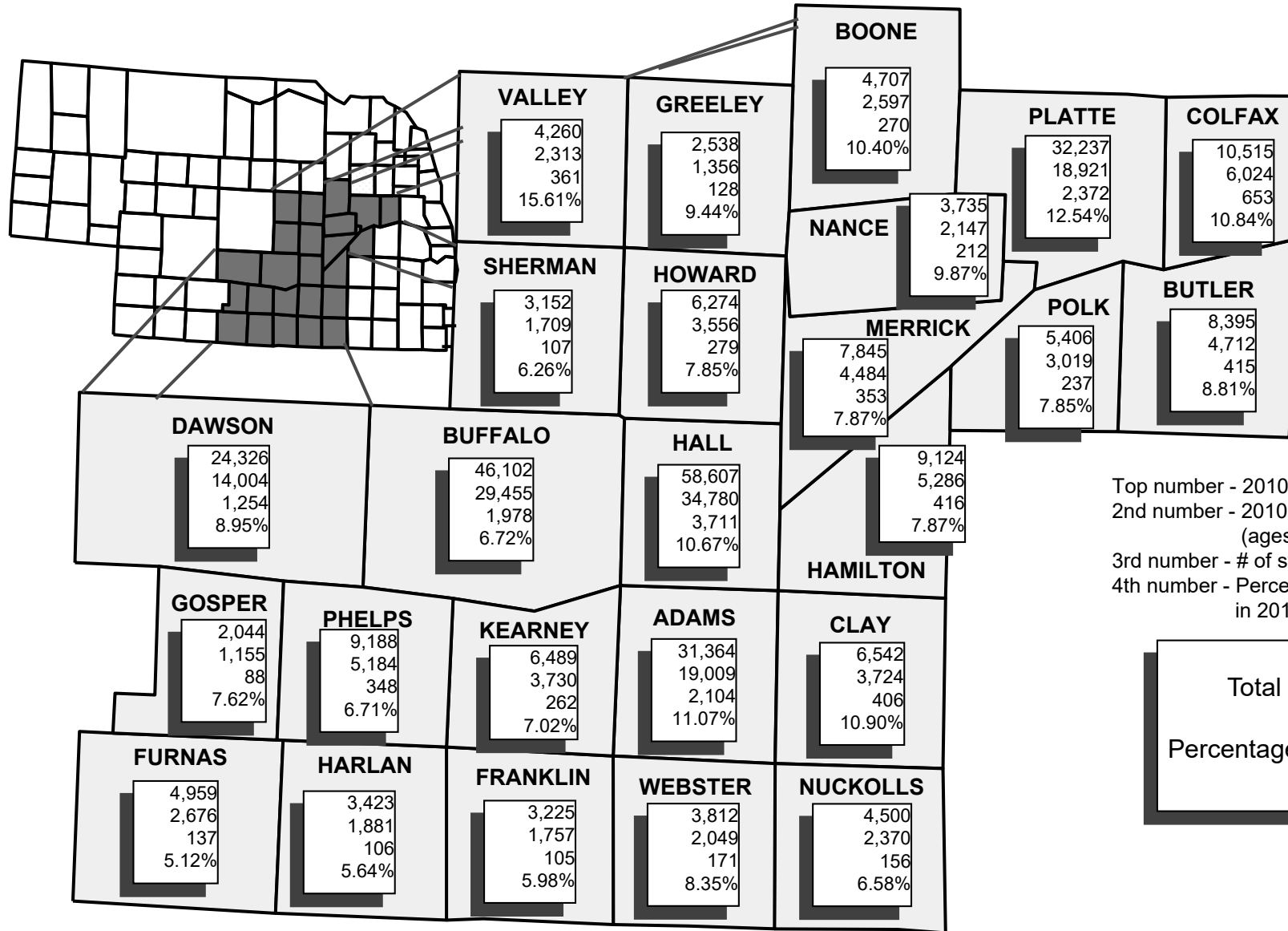

CCC County Enrollment Map



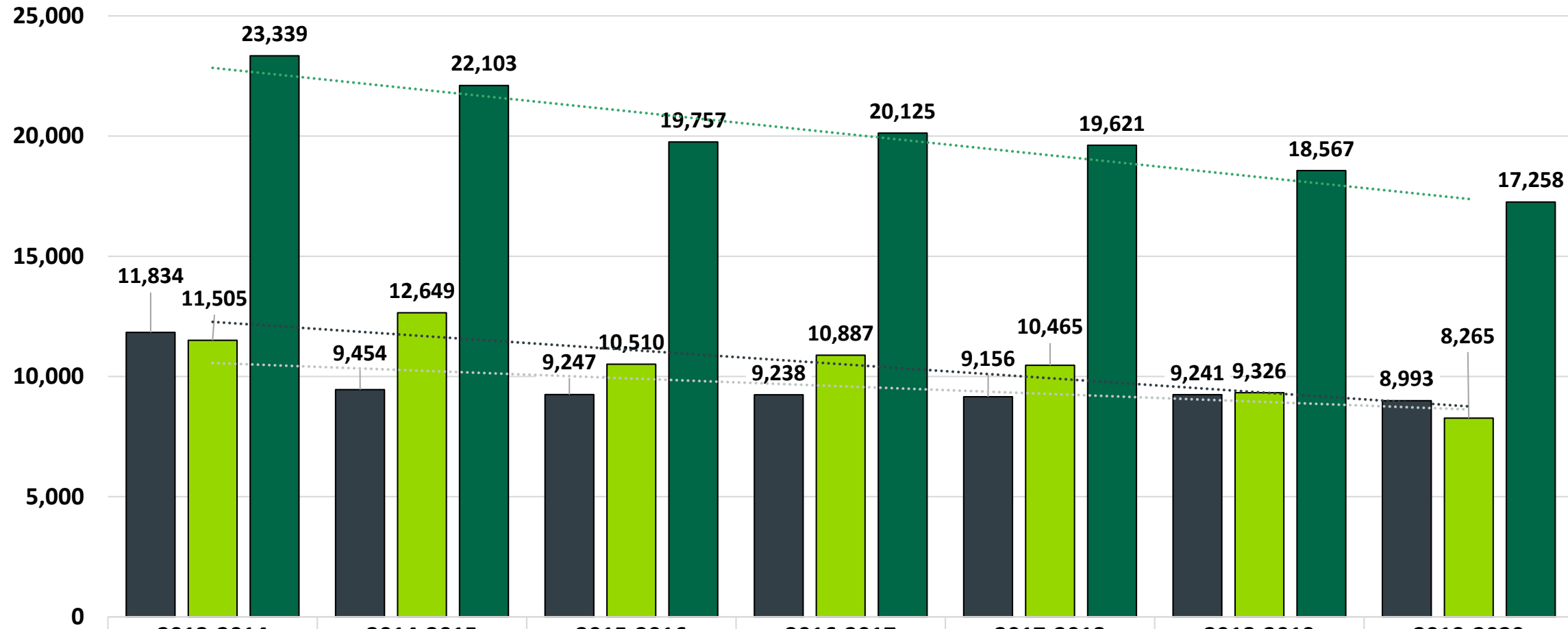

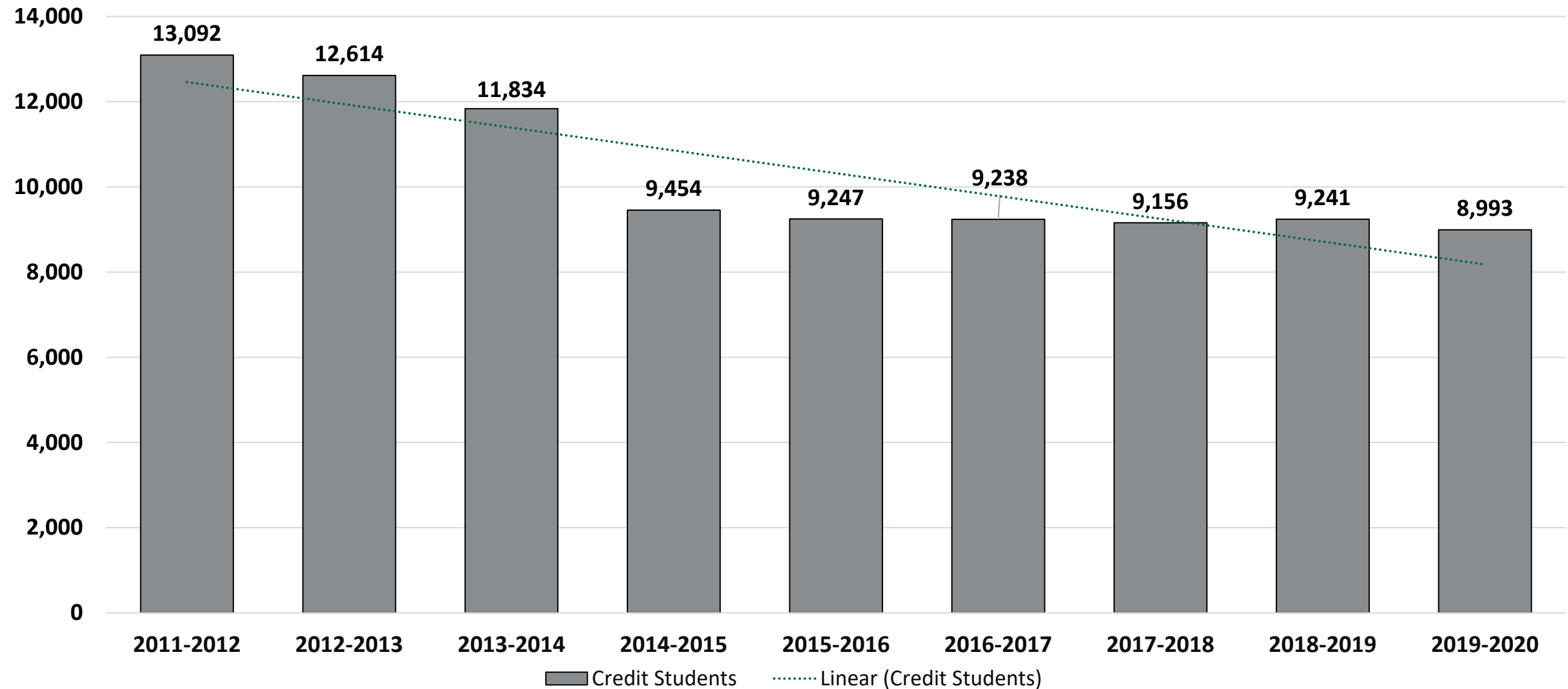

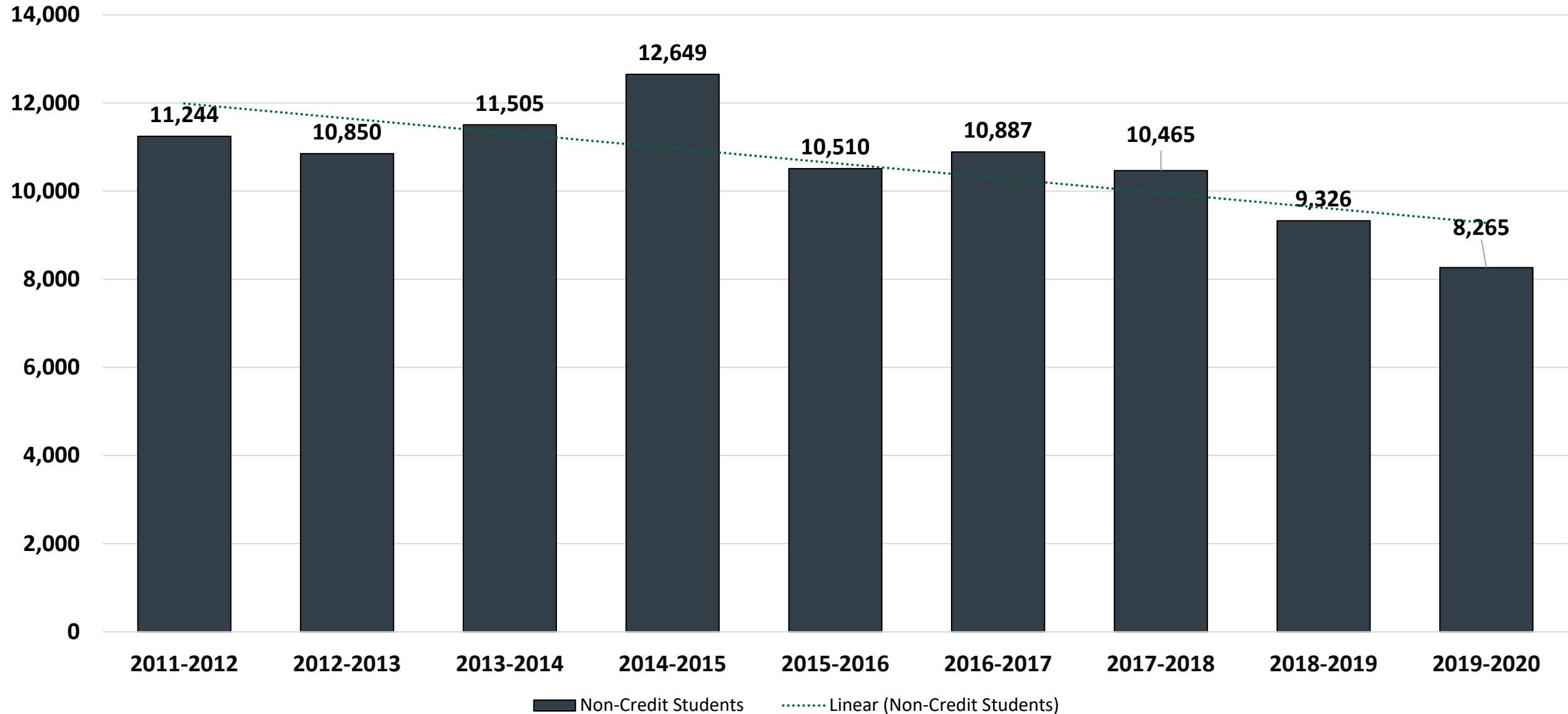

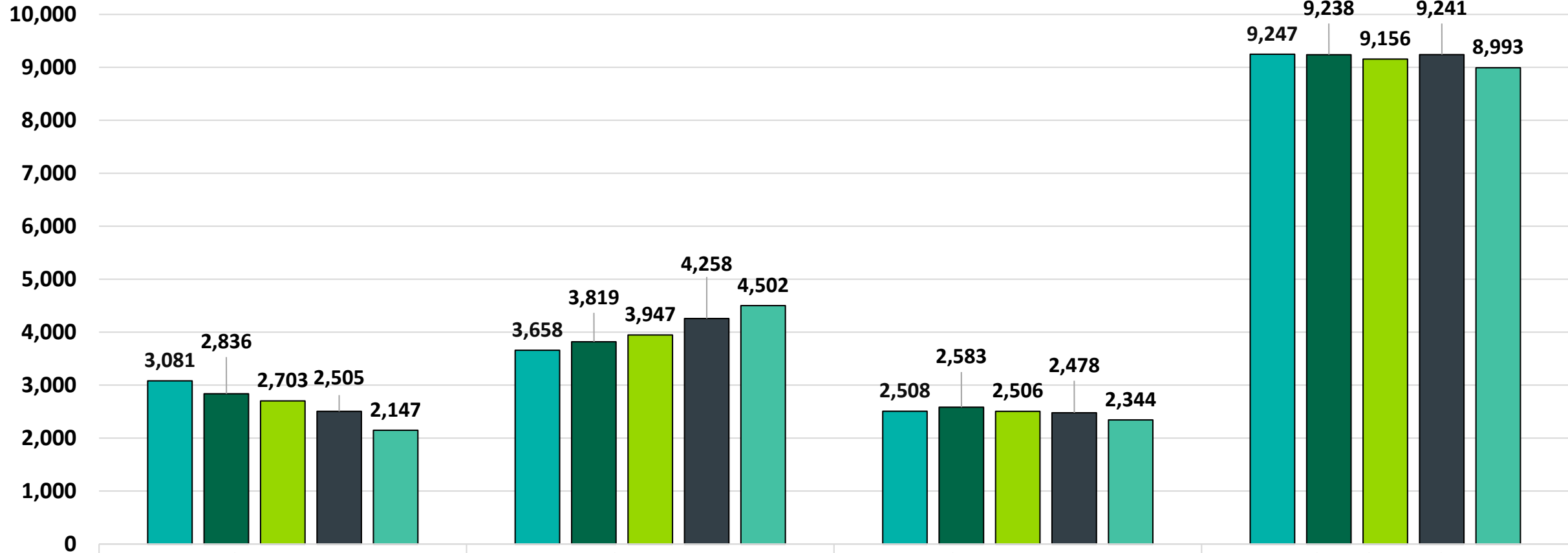
Nine-Year Unduplicated Headcount (Credit Student Only)



Nine-Year Unduplicated Headcount (Non-Credit Only)

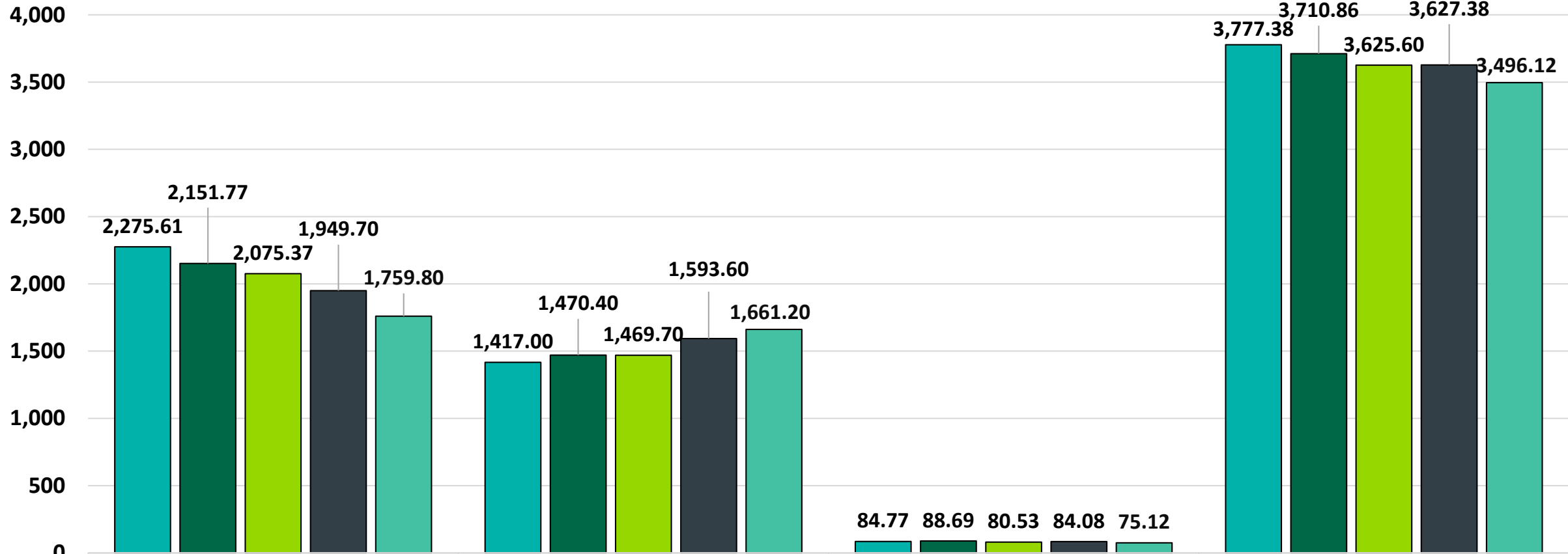


Five-Year Unduplicated Headcount Of Credit Students By Type Of Delivery



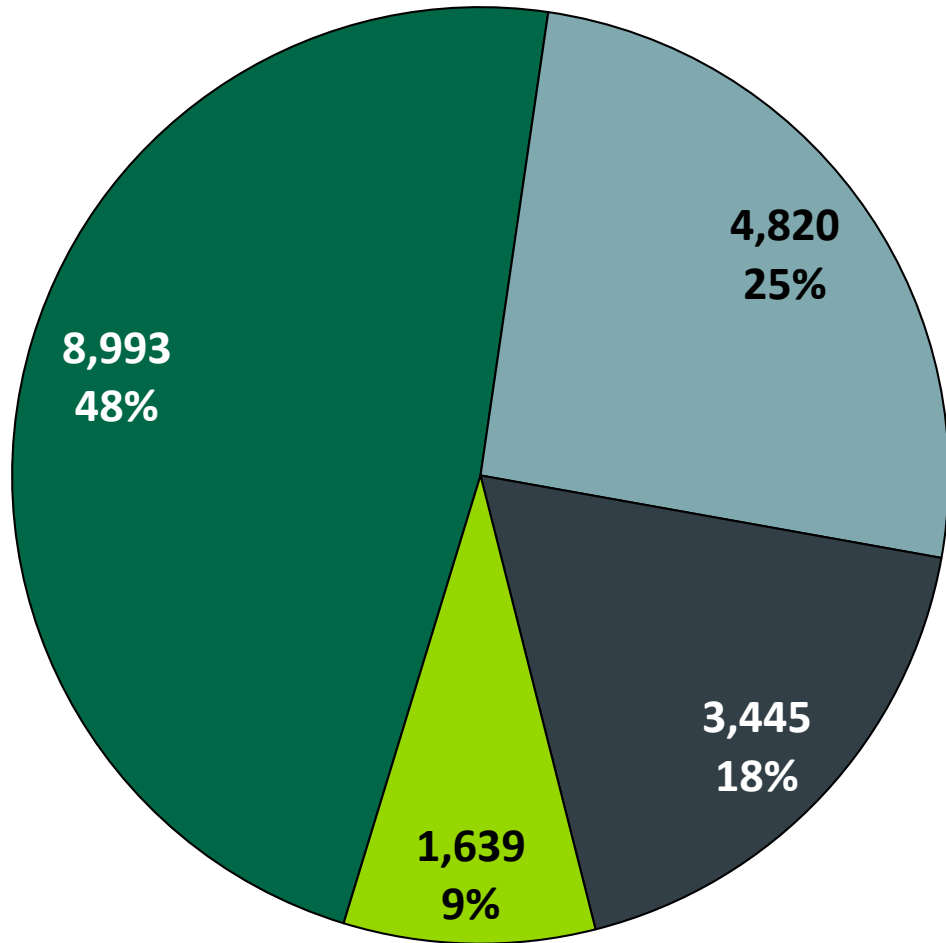

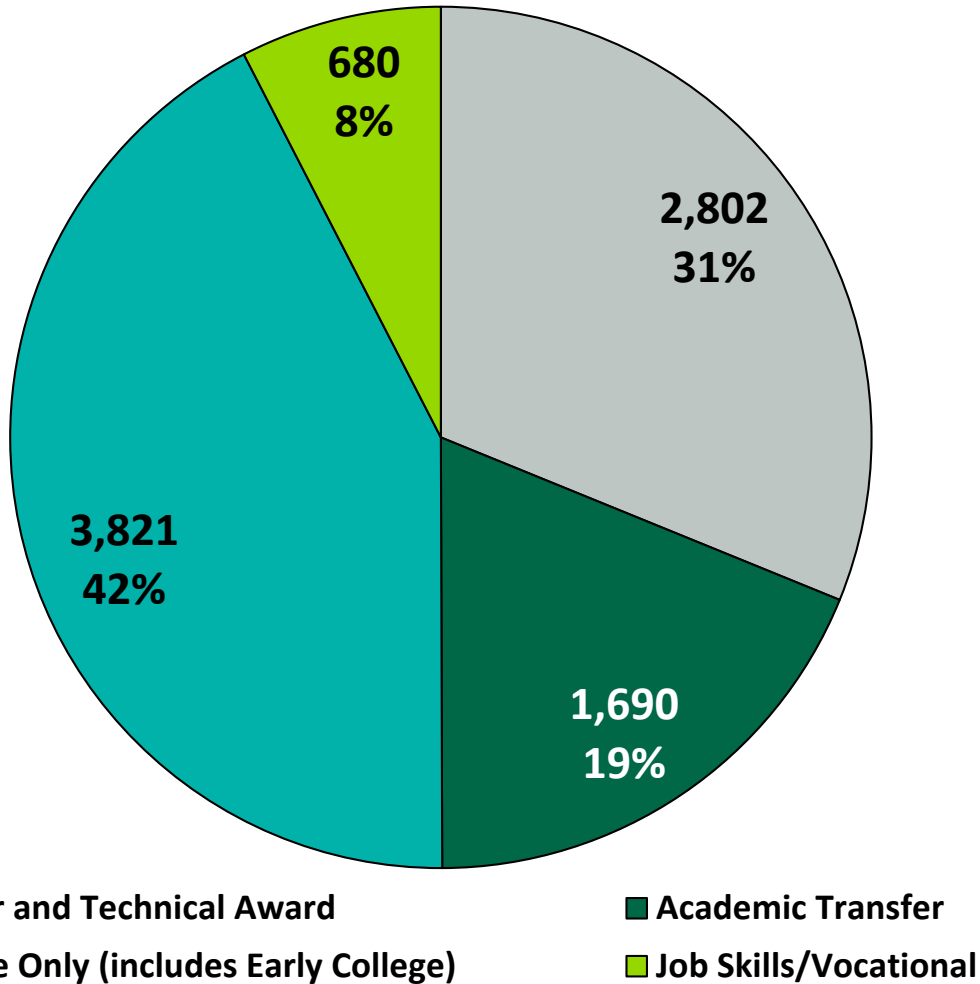

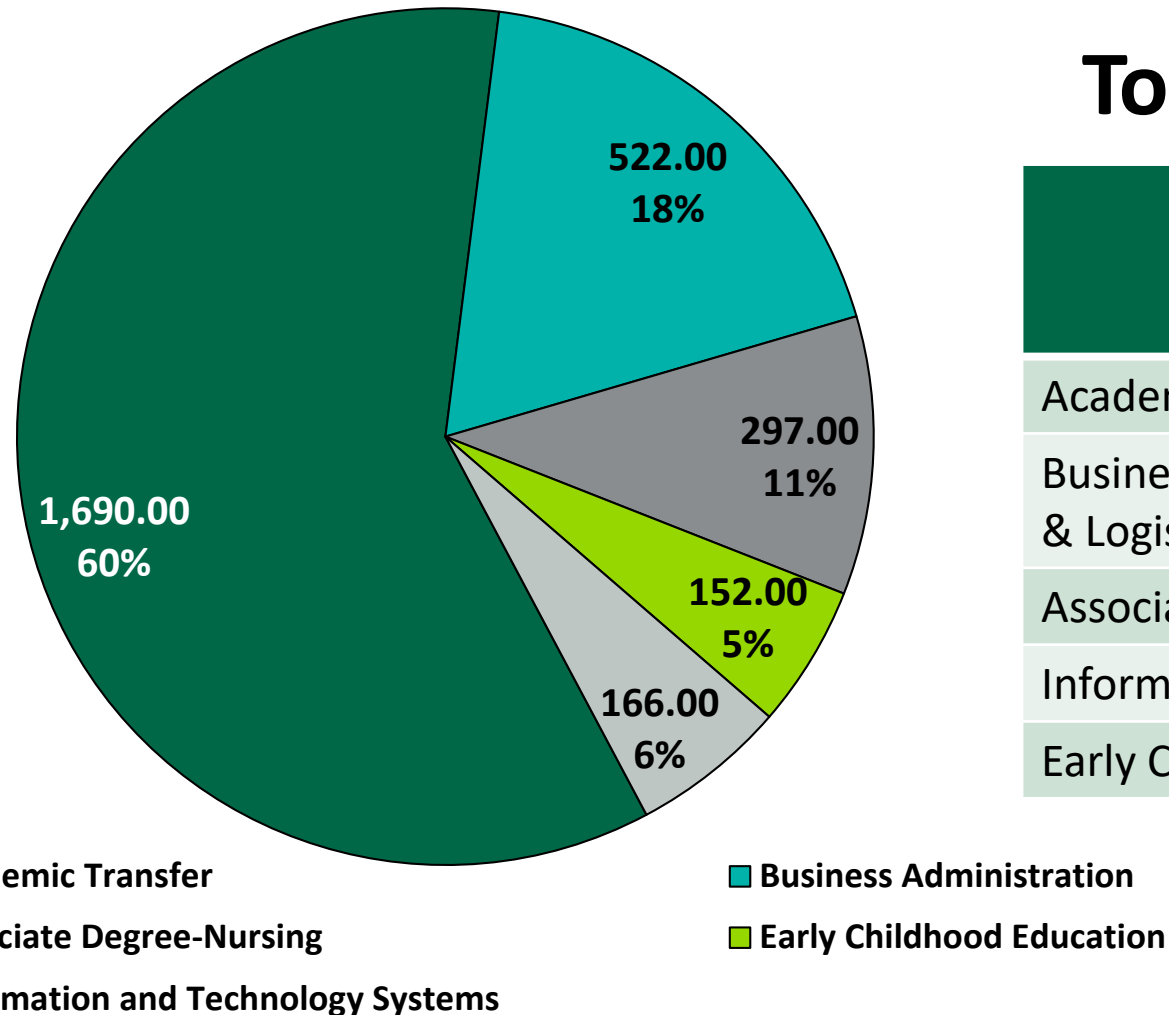

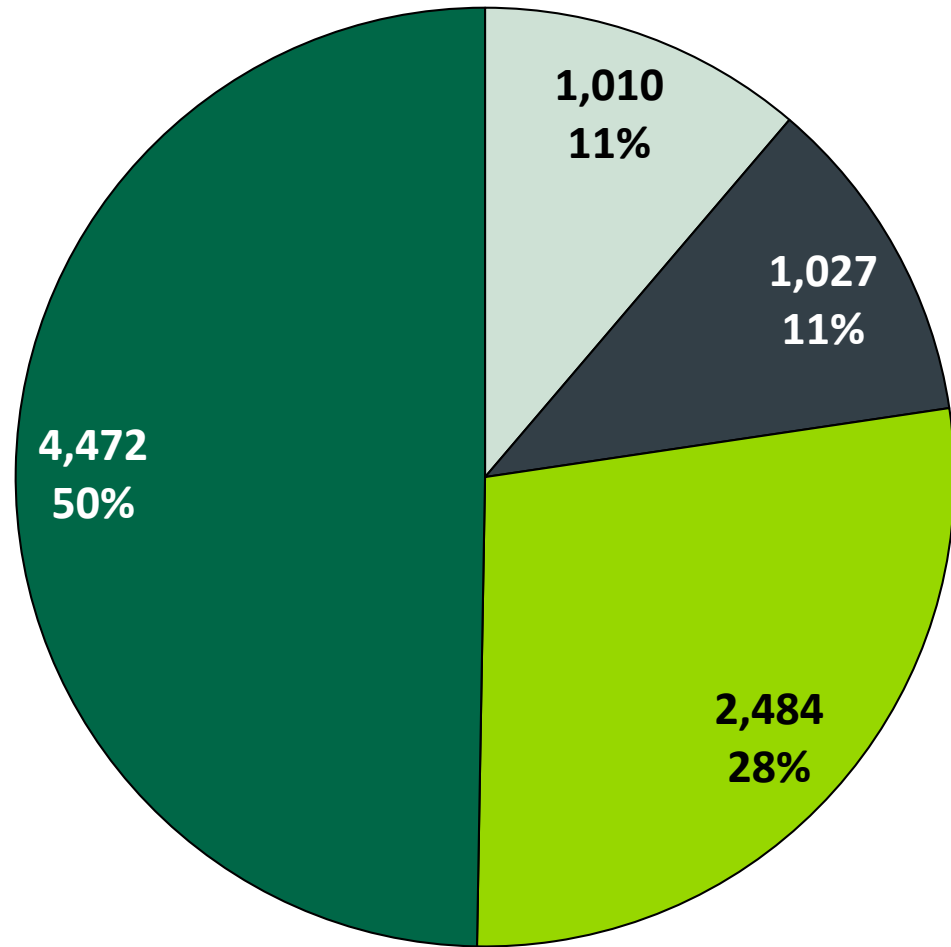

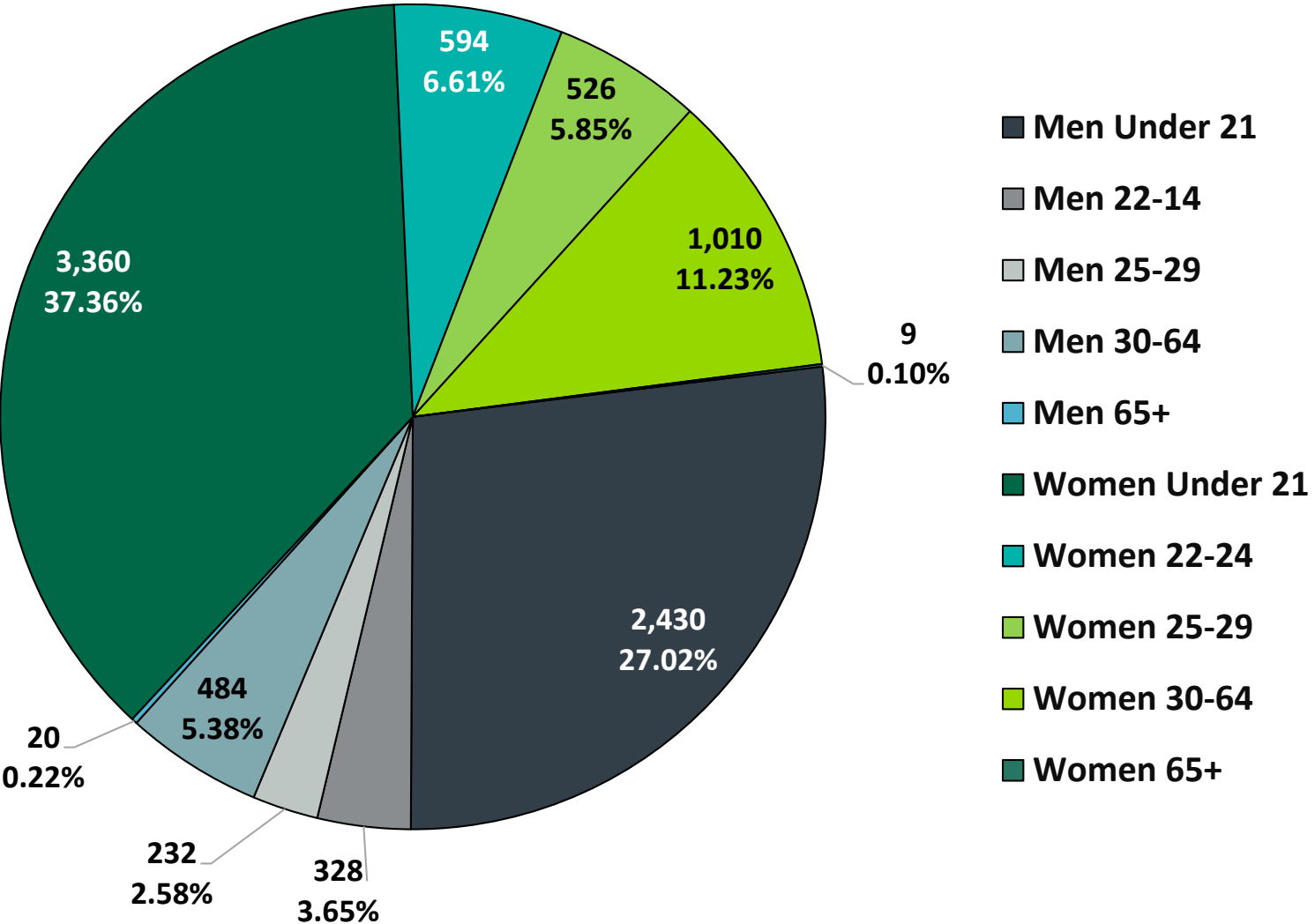

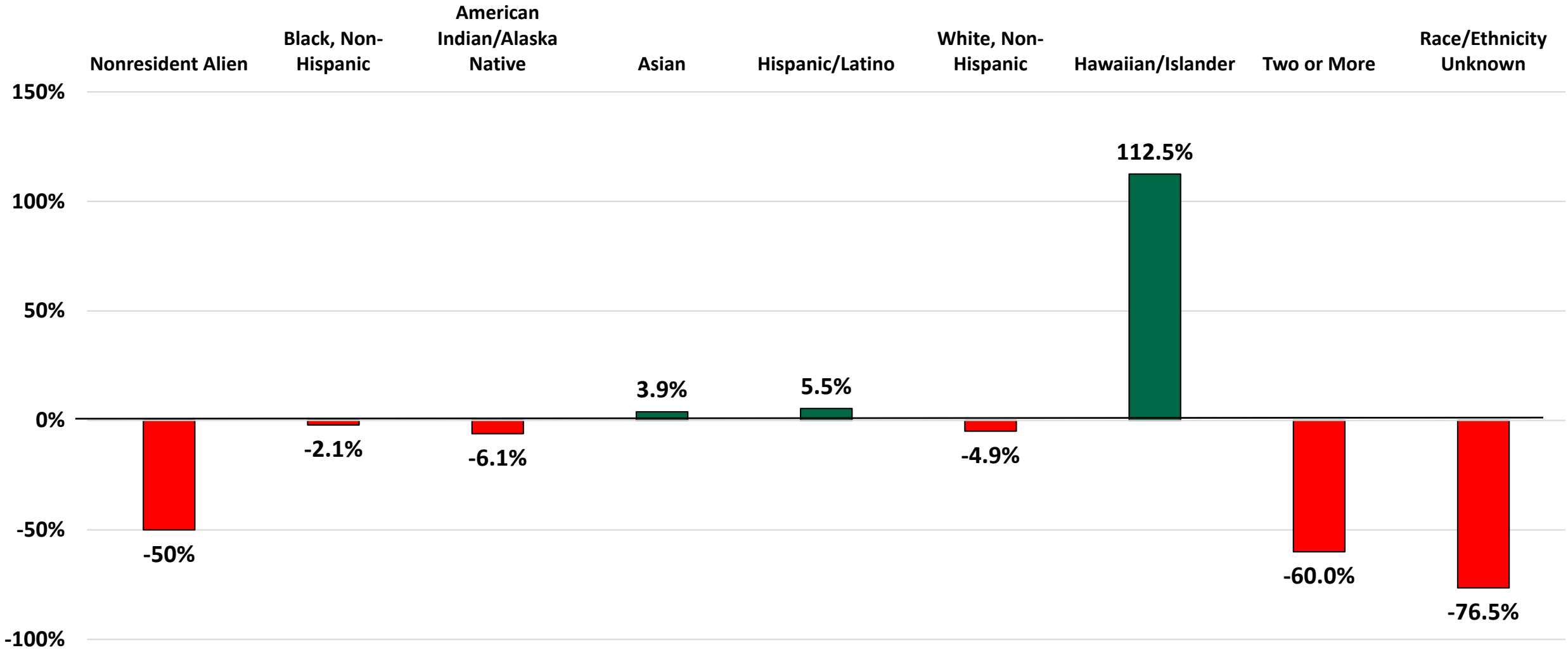

Education Level

- 733 Low ABE (Up to and including 5th grade)
 - Includes 660 ESL and 73 ABE students
- 177 Intermediate ABE (6th – 8th grade)
- 101 Adult Secondary ABE (9th – 12th grade)
 - 43 passed tests to obtain the GED
- 75,093.25 student contact hours
