TRANSCRIPTS:

High School Transcripts: Unless requested, high school transcripts are not required by CCC.

College Transcripts: For students that have taken college credit at a regionally accredited college and would like to use those credits at CCC, please request your official transcript be sent to CCC. *To be considered official, transcripts must be sent directly from the educational institution or must arrive in a sealed envelope.*

CCC prefers official transcripts to be sent electronically (through parchment or whatever service your previous institution utilizes).
