

### International Student Departure Form

This form must be completed by any international student who plans to depart the United States at the end of the current semester and will not return to take in-person classes.

The student's SEVIS record and Form I-20 will be terminated for the following reasons:

- Failure to enroll in or attend in-person classes
- Remaining outside the United States for more than five months

Once the Form I-20 is terminated, the student will no longer maintain F-1 status in the United States.

If the student intends to return to CCC to resume studies, the student must:

- Contact the Designated School Official (DSO) prior to returning
- Obtain a new initial Form I-20 and pay the SEVIS I-901 fee
- If applicable, apply for and receive a new F-1 visa before reentering (this requirement varies by individual circumstance and is the student's responsibility to confirm with U.S. consular authorities)

The student is responsible for notifying the DSO of departure plans and departure date.

The college will update the SEVIS record to reflect the student's departure and the reason for termination of F-1 status.
