



**Central Community College Athletics with Spectators Spring 2021  
Indoor Sports: Phase 1 (Jan. 4 – Jan. 30)**

1. Raider athletics will continue to follow the Raider Return-to-Play guidelines as well as college, local and state guidelines.
2. Essential personnel will include the following:
  - a. Athletic director
  - b. Athletic trainer and student workers (2)
  - c. Additional game manager (1-2)
  - d. Game officials (3)
  - e. Clock operator
  - f. Shot clock operator
  - g. Official book
  - h. Statisticians (2)
  - i. Game announcer
  - j. Live video operator
3. Central Community College athletic department will communicate competition protocols with visiting teams one week prior to a scheduled contest.
4. No spectators will be allowed to attend events during Phase 1.
5. Central Community College Raider cheer and dance will not perform in Phase 1.
6. Central Community College athletic contests will be live streamed at: [www.cccraiders.com](http://www.cccraiders.com).
7. Central Community College exercise/weight room will be unavailable for students during home contests during Phase 1 and Phase 2.

## Indoor Sports: Phase 2 (Feb. 2 – Feb. 15)

Phase 2 will be considered with all safety and health precautions maintained. Should Central Community College athletics move into Phase 2, the following would apply:

1. Visiting fans and the general public will not be permitted into any athletic events at Central Community College.
2. Home fans will be limited to four (4) immediate family members of players and coaches.
  - Individual teams will submit each guest's name to respective coach within 24 hours of the home contest. If not on the list, the spectator will not be admitted.
  - Admission tickets are \$6 for all adults; \$4 for students.
3. All spectators will enter via the west entrance of the Raider Fieldhouse.
4. All spectators at indoor competitions will wear a face covering. Failure to comply will be grounds for removal from the facility.
5. Spectators are to leave promptly after the conclusion of the contest. No waiting around, loitering, etc. for teams to come out of the locker rooms. Disinfecting wipes will be available for use.
6. Seating will be allowed only in the west bleachers with six feet of social distancing maintained. No seating will be allowed in bottom two rows to avoid crowd/athlete interactions during play.
7. Limited concessions will be available for purchase and will only include bottled drinks and packaged candy. Outside food or drinks are not permitted.
8. Central Community College Raider cheer and dance will perform in Phase 2 and will abide by the following:
  - Face coverings will be worn by team members.
  - Locker rooms will be unavailable.
  - Team meals will not be allowed in the Raider Fieldhouse
  - Dance team members will be allowed four immediate family members for admittance. Dance members will submit each guest's name to dance coach within 24 hours of the home contest. If not on the list, the spectator will not be admitted.

Central Community College will continue to monitor safety of indoor sports attendance. The recommendation to move to Phase 3 will be considered with all safety and health precautions in mind. Details surrounding Phase 3 will be forthcoming with the focus on increased spectator admittance including additional household/player guests, CCC students and employees, and Raider Booster Club members.
