In addition, over \$1,700,000 was awarded to Central Community College students in 2013-14 through institutional and privately-funded scholarships.

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION

An application for Admission must be on file with Central Community College. If you have not completed an Application for Admission, you can complete one on-line at [www.cccneb.edu](http://www.cccneb.edu).

Our scholarship application applies to all CCC general campus scholarships available. This includes scholarships offered by our Foundation, as well as those offered by each of our three main campuses. Applications are available in our financial aid offices or can be accessed at [www.cccneb.edu/financialaid](http://www.cccneb.edu/financialaid) select “apply for scholarships”.

These dates apply unless otherwise noted with the individual scholarship listing.

**Applications Available:** Late November for the following academic year

**Application Deadline:** March 1 for the following academic year

**Award Announcement:** April 15 for the following academic year

**Registration Status:** Recipients must enroll full time unless otherwise noted

**Scholarships based on need:** Some scholarships have need as one of the selection criteria. To be considered for these scholarships, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) and have a completed financial aid file in place no later than March 15.

Unless otherwise specified, scholarships awarded by the college-wide and campus selection committees are based on academic achievement, employment and school activities, quality of the personal statement, application neatness and completeness, and recommendations.

## **COLLEGE-WIDE SCHOLARSHIPS**

These scholarships are available on all three campuses. Refer to the campus listing for scholarships specific to that campus.

### **ACT Advantage Scholarship**

This \$700 tuition scholarship is awarded to current high school seniors with an ACT composite score of 21 or above and a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Eligible applicants must have submitted their ACT test scores to the CCC admissions office. Scholarship applications for the ACT Advantage Scholarship will be mailed to the student's home address during the second week of January. The scholarship deadline is February 15.

### **All-State Community College Academic Team**

Two current CCC students from each campus are nominated to receive special recognition including medallions, certificates, and oftentimes scholarships at the state capital each year. Eligible applicants must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, complete 36 semester credits, excluding foundations coursework, by the end of the fall semester and carry a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or greater. The application is available October 1<sup>st</sup> at <https://my.ptk.org/edge/my/index.php>. The application deadline is December 1.

### **Alumni Heritage Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$250 is awarded to current CCC students. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Alvena Garrido Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to diploma or degree seeking students attending any CCC campus or learning center with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or greater. Eligible applicants must be a resident of Buffalo County and earned a GED. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Amanda Schreiner Memorial Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to a traditional or nontraditional second year nursing students with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or greater. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Bosselman Family Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$300 are awarded to students involved in shop mechanics and the service writers program.

### **Buz E. Schultz Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior attending Grand Island Northwest High School, Broken Bow High School, or Fullerton High School demonstrating financial need based on the results of the FAFSA.

### **Compass Advantage Scholarship**

This \$700 tuition scholarship is awarded to current high school seniors with a minimum Compass test score of Writing 62; Reading 76; Algebra 43 and a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Eligible applicants must have submitted their test scores to the CCC admissions office. Scholarship applications for the Compass Advantage Scholarship will be mailed to the student's home address during the second week of January. The scholarship deadline is February 15.

### **Cope Foundation GED Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is to be used toward the cost of completing a GED or for students who have earned a GED and are now working toward a diploma or degree with CCC.

### **Craig HomeCare RN/LPN Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,500 are awarded to students majoring in nursing. Applicants must have the character, commitment and potential to succeed in the nursing profession with a special passion to help children. Recipients will be required to participate in a pediatric homecare clinical rotation or equivalent approved program. Selection is made by Craig HomeCare management after an interview process. Recipients must be enrolled at least three quarter time.

### **Davis/Chambers Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$2,500 are awarded to current high school seniors or current CCC students who graduated from a Nebraska high school or earned a GED. This scholarship program recognizes academically promising students from diverse backgrounds. Eligible applicants must be a U.S. Citizen, Nebraska resident and demonstrate financial need based on the results of the FAFSA. Recipients must plan to enroll in a Nebraska four-year public institution after attending CCC. Scholarship deadline is April 1. Applications are available from high school guidance counselors or CCC financial aid offices.

### **Dawson County Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$250 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student who is a resident of Dawson County.

### **Dorothy Jacobsen Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$250 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student.

### **Dr. Chester Gausman Endowment Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student.

### **Dr. Dennis Tyson Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student.

### **Drs. Greg & Marilee Smith Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$1,000 is awarded to a current high school senior or a current CCC student.

### **Dr. Joseph W. Preusser Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a first-year, non-traditional student. Preference will be given to an applicant demonstrating financial need based on the results of the FAFSA. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Dr. LaVern Franzen Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student.

### **Edgar & Frances Reynolds Foundation Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students residing in the following counties: Hall, Merrick, Buffalo, Adams, Howard or Hamilton. Recipients majoring in allied health, advanced manufacturing design technology, automotive technology, diesel technology, business administration or business technology.

### **Ed R. Crowley Jr. Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior ranking in the top 50 percent of his or her graduating class and/or current CCC students with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or greater. Preference will be given to applicants demonstrating financial need based on the results of the FAFSA.

### **Employee Gifts for Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students.

### **Jim & Nancy Reier Nursing Scholarship**

This scholarship for \$500 is awarded to second year nontraditional nursing students with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Preference will be given to an applicant demonstrating financial need based on the results of the FAFSA, as well as character, commitment, and dedication to the field of nursing. Selection is made by the scholarship donor.

### **June Yost Nursing Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to students accepted into the associate degree nursing program with a cumulative grade point average of 2.8 or greater. Preference will be given to Good Samaritan Village employees, followed by nontraditional students and those demonstrating financial need based on the results of the FAFSA.

### **Karen Baird Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student. Preference will be given to the applicant who has volunteered in their community within the CCC 25 county area.

### **Kaufman-Cummings Trust Scholarship**

These scholarships for \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors attending Grand Island Senior High School, Grand Island Northwest High School, Grand Island Central Catholic High School, Heartland Lutheran High School, Doniphan-Trumbull High School, Wood River High School or Centura High School who reside in Hall County. Preference will be given to individuals demonstrating financial need based on the results of the FAFSA.

### **Ken Morrison Scholarship for Health Occupations**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to students accepted in any of the allied health care programs with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Eligible programs include: dental assisting, dental hygiene, health information management services, medical laboratory technology, medical assisting, occupational therapy assistant, nursing, and paramedicine. Dollars must be used for tuition, fees, books, equipment and uniforms.

### **Ken Wortman Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship is for up to \$200 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student.

### **Larry & Barbara Schnase Family Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student.

### **Mable Gentry Gade Scholarship**

These \$1,000 scholarships are awarded to female high school seniors and/or current female CCC students. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student.

### **Myrtle B. Grimminger Endowed Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students who reside in Hall County or graduated from a Hall County high school. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Nebraska Cable Communications Association Scholarship**

One scholarship for \$500 is awarded every other year to a current high school senior or current CCC student with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Preference will be given to students majoring in business administration, electronics technology, electrical technology, information technology, and business technology. Scholarship funding is for tuition, fees, or books. Previous recipients of this award are ineligible. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Richard & Marlene Hinrichs Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student. Preference will be given to a graduating high school senior demonstrating financial need based on the results of the FAFSA.

### **Roy and Mary Pearson Nursing Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student majoring in nursing.

### **Service Award Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student. Employees' electing to donate the monetary value of their gift received from CCC for their years of service are combined into this fund.

### **Students at a Distance Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current CCC student seeking a diploma or degree at a distance through CCC with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Eligible applicants must have successfully completed at least six credit hours of coursework delivered at a distance through CCC during the prior year. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Timpte, Inc. Scholarship**

These scholarships providing tuition and fees for up to \$5,280 are awarded to current high school seniors or current CCC students whose parents are employed by Timpte, Inc. Students must be enrolled full-time during the fall and spring terms and may attend during summer sessions up to reaching the maximum amount of the award.

### **Veteran's Appreciation Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to student veterans or dependents of a family member veteran of any branch of the United States Armed Service with or without VA educational assistance.

## **Yearend Appeal Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students.

### **Art Scholarship**

These tuition scholarships for up to \$600 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students majoring in art or electronic imaging and graphics. Eligible applicants must provide a portfolio demonstrating creativity and technique through different media. Selection is made by the program instructor.

### **Behlen Mfg. Co. Scholarship**

Two scholarships providing one year's tuition of up to fifteen credit hours per semester are awarded to current high school seniors whose parents are employed by Behlen. Scholarships are renewable for the student's second year of study.

### **Ben Teller Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior graduating from a Platte County high school.

### **Black Hills Energy Scholarship**

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a current high school senior ranked in the top 50 percent of his or her graduating class or a non-traditional student who lives in a town served by Black Hills Energy. Preference will be given to students majoring in appliance repair, HVAC, construction management, business, marketing, or economics.

### **Chartwells Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current CCC students. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Claude S. Breedeen Scholarship**

These scholarships ranging from \$500-\$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater majoring in mechatronics. Eligible applicants must demonstrate financial need based on the results of the FAFSA and attend full-time with a minimum of six credit hours in mechatronics courses during the year. Funding is provided by the Packaging Machinery Manufacturers Institute. Recipients are chosen by the industrial technology program instructors.

### **Columbus Area Chamber of Commerce Agriculture Committee Scholarship**

Four \$250 scholarships are awarded for the spring term to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students majoring in agriculture. Recipients are chosen by the agriculture program instructor. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Columbus Campus Support Staff Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$300 is awarded to a current CCC student who has been out of high school at least five years. Eligible applicants must be working toward a certificate, diploma, or degree and have completed a minimum of six credit hours with CCC. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Columbus Noon Rotary Club Scholarship**

This \$300 scholarship is awarded to a current high school senior attending Columbus Senior High School, Lakeview High School or Scotus Central Catholic High School.

### **Dance Scholarships**

These tuition scholarships worth up to \$1,100 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Selection is made through audition and interview by the dance team sponsors and instructor. Recipients must enroll in Performance Dance Foundations I or II.

### **Drama Scholarships**

These tuition scholarships worth up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Selection is made through audition and interview by the theater program instructor. Recipients must enroll in theater courses and participate in the fall and spring productions.

### **Dr. Emily Jane Uzendowski**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or a current CCC student who resides in Boone or Nance County. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Dr. Peter D. Rush Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or a current CCC student.

### **Educational Achievement Scholarship**

These tuition scholarships worth up to \$1,500 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **EducationQuest Foundation Scholarship**

These scholarships ranging from \$300 to \$2,500 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Recipients must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident and a Nebraska resident. Recipients must demonstrate financial need based on the results of the FAFSA and receive a Pell Grant or be just above the cut-off for a Pell Grant. Preference will be given to first-generation students, underrepresented minority students, or students who face obstacles to higher education. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Employee Gifts for Scholars Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$800 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students.

### **Fine & Performing Arts Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$750 is awarded to a student who participates in fine & performing arts courses on the Columbus campus. This scholarship is available for books, required supplies, or tuition assistance.

### **Follett Bookstore Scholarship**

These \$50 Follett Bookstore gift cards are awarded throughout the academic year for various club and student activities.

### **Herbert P. "Mike" and Lois V. Behlen Memorial Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students.

## **Intercollegiate Athletic Scholarships**

Athletic awards are awarded to participants in the women's basketball, women's softball, women's volleyball, men's basketball, men's golf, and men's soccer programs. Awards are in the form of partial tuition waivers valued for up to one year's tuition. Selection is made by the athletic coaches based on athletic performance and skill evaluations through tryouts. Individuals that are selected must adhere to regulations set by the National Junior College Athletic Association.

## **Kawasaki Scholarship**

Two \$500 scholarships are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Recipients must be eligible to work in the U.S. and be a Nebraska resident. Preference will be given to degree seeking students in welding, mechatronics, business, or engineering programs. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

## **Larry Kaus Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior attending Lindsay Holy Family, Humphrey St. Francis or Scotus Central Catholic High School.

## **Lindsay Welding Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a student majoring in welding technology.

## **Linkages Achievement Scholarship**

These tuition waiver scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors who participate in the Linkages industrial education programs at Columbus Senior High School. Dollars must be used for tuition only.

## **Loup Power District Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors who reside in Boone, Colfax, Nance or Platte County whose parents are a Loup Power District customer.

## **Lucille and Dr. Ed Filipi Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student majoring in the healthcare field. Preference will be given to a student in the Leigh and Clarkson area and if funding is available for a student who resides in Platte County. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

## **Martha & Robert Lund Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior from Columbus Senior High School, Lakeview High School or Scotus Central Catholic High School ranking in the upper 50% of his or her graduating class with a grade point average of 2.5 or greater.

## **Mary J. Graf Memorial Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors ranking the top 25% of his or her graduating class and/or current CCC students with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or greater who reside in Boone, Butler, Colfax, Madison, Merrick, Nance, Platte, Polk or Stanton County.

## **Memorial Fund Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students.

## **Music Scholarships**

These tuition scholarships worth up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Selection is made through audition and interview by the music program instructors. Recipients must enroll in music courses and participate in performance groups.

## **Nebraska Open Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students. Recipients must be Nebraska resident and carry a 2.5 cumulative grade point average or greater. Preference will be given to students who major in accounting, business administration, business technology, drafting, electrical/electronics, engineering, environmental science, information technology, journalism, lineman courses, mechanical craft, plant operations, political science, pre-engineering, or welding.

## **New Business and Technology Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students. Applicants must be majoring in business administration and accounting, business technology or information technology.

## **Paul Peterson Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior whose parent is employed by Loup Power District. Priority is given to applicants in a business-related major. The scholarship may be renewed for the student's second year of study.

## **Paul Rebrovich Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current high school senior ranked in the upper one-third of his or her high school graduating class majoring in education or psychology.

## **Peter Kiewit Foundation Scholarship**

Ten \$1,000 scholarships are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students pursuing a vocational diploma or degree program with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Recipients must be a U.S. Citizen and a Nebraska resident and must demonstrate financial need based on the results of the FAFSA.

## **Platte County Agriculture Society Scholarships**

Four \$1,000 scholarships (\$500 per year for two years) are awarded to current high school seniors whose parents are residents of Platte County. A recipient will be selected from Columbus Senior High School, Lakeview High School, Scotus Central Catholic High School, and a high school outside of the Columbus area.

## **Ray Plankinton Scholarship**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a current CCC student with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or greater majoring in math or engineering. Recipient must be enrolled at least part time.

## **Tech Prep Scholarship**

Four \$500 tuition scholarships are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Recipients must meet tech prep requirements and complete responses to the tech prep essay questions.

### **Vince Lempke Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship for up to \$500 is awarded to a current CCC student with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater in the math or science programs. Recipient must be enrolled at least part time.

### **Vishay Intertechnology Inc. Scholarship**

Two scholarships providing one year's tuition and fees of up to fifteen credit hours per semester are awarded to current high school seniors whose parents are employed by Vishay. Scholarships are renewable for the student's second year of study.

### **Welding Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students. Preference will be given to students majoring in welding or advanced manufacturing design technology. Funding is provided by Columbus Hydraulics and Duo Lift manufacturing. Recipient must be enrolled at least part time.

### **Yearend Appeal Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors and/or current CCC students.

### **Academic Achievement Scholarship**

These tuition scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current CCC students. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Academic Excellence Scholarship**

These tuition scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current high school seniors. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Academic Opportunity Scholarship**

These tuition scholarships are for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **AM Islander Kiwanis Club Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current CCC students. Recipients must be single parents enrolled in the early childhood education, elementary education or pediatric nursing program.

### **Bicycle Ride Across Nebraska Scholarship**

This \$750 scholarship is awarded to a current CCC student, who graduated from a Nebraska high school, with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or greater.

### **Bud and Gloria Wolbach Nursing Scholarship**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student majoring in nursing. Recipient must be a single mother and enrolled at least half time.

### **CCC-Lexington Center Give Big Lexington Scholarship**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student attending classes at the CCC-Lexington Center.

### **Chartwells Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current CCC students. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Claussen Charitable Trust (Earl & Maxine) Scholarship**

One \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student majoring a construction related program. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Don Nelson Memorial Scholarship**

This is awarded to a current CCC student. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Dr. Lynn and Joan Black Scholarship**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a current CCC student with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater. Recipient must be enrolled at least half time.

### **EducationQuest Foundation Scholarship**

These scholarships ranging from \$300 to \$2,500 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Recipients must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident and a Nebraska resident. Recipients must demonstrate financial need based on the results of the FAFSA and receive a Pell Grant or be just above the cut-off for a Pell Grant. Preference will be given to first-generation students, underrepresented minority students, or students who face obstacles to higher education. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Employee Appeal Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$500 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Recipients must enroll at least half time.

### **Employee Gifts for Scholars Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$800 are awarded to current high school seniors and current CCC students. Recipients must enroll at least half time.

### **Faculty/Staff Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current CCC students pursuing a degree program and have completed 24 credit hours at CCC. Recipients must be enrolled at least half time.

### **Follett Bookstore Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$250 each are awarded to current high school seniors and /or current CCC students. Follett bookstore gift cards in the amount of the award will be issued to recipients.

### **Gloria Wolbach Nursing Scholarship**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a single mother in the nursing program.

### **Grand Island Faculty and Staff Scholarship**

These \$1,000 scholarships are awarded to a current high school seniors and/or current CCC students.

### **Grand Island Sunrise Rotary Scholarship**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a current high school senior or current CCC student.

### **Industrial Technology/Mechatronics Scholarship**

These scholarships for up to \$1,000 are awarded to current CCC students and/or current high school seniors with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or greater.
